CO2 calculation for Wehea

- 240 hectares of CO2 are bound in one hectare of primary rainforest
- If destroyed, 1 ha of rainforest releases 450 tons of CO2
- at Wehea: 22,500,000 tonnes of CO2 are bounded
- Source: Save the Rainforest association and Ludwig Maximilian University Munich

Current Project Figures Wehea

One time investment

- Pick-Up car: around 28.000 USD
- 2 Moto cycles: around 12.000 USD
- Maintenance of the street/new bridge: around 10.000 USD
- Maintenance of the building: around 10.000 USD

Yearly ongoing costs

- Salary for the ranger: 45.000 USD
- Maintenance Infrastruktur: 6.000 USD

Possible Second Project Phase

One time investment

- Possible extension rainforest area
- Idea will be supported by the locals and Indonesian forest minister
- New buildings and infrastructure extension
- Figures have to be calculated and negotiated

Running costs

- More staff / rangers necessary salary increase
- Higher maintenance costs
- Figures have to be calculated later



Why are new partner necesary for Wehea?

According to renowned scientists the conservation of tropical rainforests is vital for the survival of the earth

Wehea with its unique rainforests must be preserved for the next generations

There are other potential / similar 6 projects in Indonesia waiting for support

The destruction of the rainforests continues unabated, which means that the financial expenditure for these projects increases steadily

In order to be able to achieve the goals urgently need strong partner
